## Outline of Services

### 1. Resource Efficiency Workshops

- Provide four ½ day events, some suggested topics include:
  - Introduction to Resource Efficiency/Waste Legislation
  - Data collection and Environmental Performance Indicators
  - Designing out Waste
  - Site Waste Management Plans

### 2. Forum for collaborative learning - Occasional networking/open space meetings

### 3. Telephone helpline

- Provision of technical helpline on resource efficiency.
- Up to a maximum of 4hrs per member per year

### 4. Environmental Legislation Briefing

- Provision of regular legal updates to all members

### 5. Environmental Management Workshops

- Provide an additional four ½ day events, some suggested topics include:
  - Undertaking site environmental assessments
  - Introduction to non-waste environmental legislation
  - Carbon accounting/footprinting
  - Legislation update

### 6. One-to-one support

- One of the following per member company out of the following:
  - Waste audit
  - Best Practice planning workshop
  - SWMP workshop with sub-contractors
  - Senior management briefing
  - Toolbox talks (3 max)
  - Other topic subject to agreement

### 7. Carbon Footprint Analysis

- Calculation of a basic carbon footprint of either:
  - A project or
  - The member's operational activities.
  - *A basic carbon footprint consists of the analysis of member provided data using available carbon data and the delivery of a simple bullet point action plan.*
